## Progress Pride Flag @ GPS

This June we celebrate Pride Month at GPS! The month-long celebration is a way to recognize the impact that 2SLGTBQIA+ [two-spirit, lesbian, gay, transgender, bisexual, queer or questioning, intersex, asexual] individuals have had on history locally, nationally, and internationally.

The progress pride flag, which was created in 2018, has a five-coloured chevron that represents "racialized people and transgender identity, placing greater emphasis on intersectionality and progression. Raising the flag will visibly highlight our continued commitment to ensuring equity, dignity, well-being, diversity, and inclusion of the 2SLGBTQIA+ community in TLDSB.
